Job Description

In coordination with the Municipal Authority Manager, performs work involving the operation and maintenance of the sewage and storm water collection systems including but not limited to; pump stations, equipment, buildings, grounds and all related structures. Must also be able to augment the Public Works department at times to complete large projects such as paving or snow plowing.

Applicants must be available 24/7 for emergency call outs due to sewer issues, winter weather events, wet weather events or any other natural disaster.

Required Skills

- Strong reading, math, writing, scientific and verbal communication skills
- Strong mechanical aptitude and ability to read, interpret and record data from meters, gauges, scales, panels, computer consoles and other equipment.
- Ability to read and interpret data from maps, engineering drawings, blueprints, gauges and graphs.
- Strong troubleshooting/ problem solving skills, provide input for corrective action and implement those actions as needed.
- Computer skills to include Microsoft based programs, SCADA systems.
- Ability to read and understand technical instructions and manuals.
- Knowledge of and integrity to follow proper Industry Environmental, Health and Safety policies, procedures and requirements.
- Possess or ability to obtain within 6 months of date of hire a PA class "B" CDL license with a tank endorsement.
- Physical ability to lift and carry heavy loads over 75 pounds.
- Ability to enter and work in manholes, catch basins and other confined spaces.
- Must be able to work outside in all weather conditions.
- Must be able to climb or walk ladders and stairs.
- Effective customer service attitude and commitment to providing exceptional customer service and quality results.

Required Experience

- Mechanical background of at least 1 year in pneumatic, hydraulic, electrical, pumps and internal combustion engines.
