

Dear Lower Swatara Township Resident,

Effective January 1st, 2017 Lebanon Farms Disposal, Inc., will be taking over the trash and recycling collection for the township. The transition to our company will create a change in your collection day, though the limit of trash and recycling you will be allowed to place curbside will remain the same as well as your bulk item pickup.

The information we received from the township confirmed that your current collection is either a Monday or Tuesday, depending on your address. The new scheduled collection days for the township, effective January 1st, 2017, will be Thursday and Friday.

The transition will occur as follows for collection days and we ask that you have your items out no later than 5:00am on the day of your pick up:

- All previous Monday pickups will occur on Fridays – (1st collection will be January 6th, 2017)
- All previous Tuesday pickups will occur on Thursdays – (1st collection will be January 5th, 2017)

As part of our agreement with the township, you will be provided with a new 96 gallon trash cart and 64 gallon recycling cart, which will be delivered directly to your home no later than March 31st, 2017. If your trash cart is too big, you may opt for a smaller size (64 gallon or 32 gallon). If you opt for a smaller size you must notify us no later than 30 days after delivery of cart.

Christmas Tree pickup will occur on Thursday and Friday, January 12th and 13th, 2017. Please make sure trees are free of any lights and ornaments and are not bagged.

If any of the information we were provided from the township records is incorrect, please let us know. If you could kindly complete the form on the back of your remittance ticket with the correct information along with your phone number, it would be greatly appreciated. You can also contact our office at 800-533-5356 Monday thru Friday from 7:00am-5:00pm to update this information. Thank you and we look forward to working with you in the future.

MATERIALS ACCEPTED

Paper – Clean; Placed in recycling bin

Newspaper & inserts
Magazines & catalogs
Junk mail, envelopes, file folders
Office white, colored and computer paper
Shredded office waste paper (must be in clear plastic bag)
Cardboard (must be bundled or flattened and placed in or next to recycling bin)
Phone books
Paper towel and toilet paper cores
Pizza Boxes (unsoiled)
Paperboard (food/cereal boxes)

Containers – Empty & Cleaned Out; loose (not in plastic bags)

Aluminum cans (beer & soda)
Metal food cans (tin/steel); metal lids
Aerosol cans
Glass bottles & jars (food & drink only)
Plastic bottles, jugs, and jars (such as soda, water, milk, juice, shampoo, detergent, condiments, salad dressing, yogurt/margarine containers, etc.)

NO RECYCLING WILL BE ACCEPTED IN PLASTIC BAGS

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

Ceramics, dishes, coffee cups, drinking glasses
Glass cookware/bakeware (Pyrex, Vision Ware, etc.)
Window glass, mirrors, light bulbs
Plastic bags, Styrofoam containers, packaging peanuts
Takeout containers, plastic cups, and plastic tableware. No Aluminum foil or foil plates, etc.
Containers of hazardous or toxic materials
Tissue or paper towels, books, Tyvek envelopes, carbon paper
Paper cartons for milk or juice. Wax coated boxes
Toys, household appliances, coat hangers
Construction debris, scrap metal
